Cyfarfu'r pwyllgor sawl gwaith dros y deuddeg mis diwethaf dros Teams a gyda chyfarfodydd yn cynnwys holl swyddogion CFFI Cymru, a fu'n gweithio ochr yn ochr â phanel o arbenigwyr pwyllgor y mae'r sefydliad yn ddyledus iddynt am eu presenoldeb a'u cefnogaeth, sef Kathryn Jones, Steve Hughson a Hilary Jones.

Ymddiswyddodd Mr Malcolm Thomas o'r pwyllgor ym mis Rhagfyr 2022 a diolchwyd iddo am ei amser a roddodd i'r sefydliad.

Derbyniwyd grant Iaith Gymraeg a chefnogodd swydd Datblygu'r Gymraeg, cyflogau staff eraill a'r 12 Sir. Ein Swyddog Datblygu'r Gymraeg oedd yn gyfrifol am fonitro'r grant hwn o ddydd i ddydd. Cefnogodd Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol yr NFU y rhaglen Agri I lle cafodd 8 aelod eu hariannu i archwilio arferion ffermio amrywiol. Defnyddiwyd cyllid WCVA a oedd wedi'i neilltuo yn gychwynnol i gefnogi swyddog incwm, ar gyfer datblygu a gweithredu Strategaeth Incwm. Roedd cyllid NYVO wedi'i golli yn 2022. Chefnogodd y pwyllgor yr uwch staff gyda'r cais i ailymgeisio am gyllid a roedden yn llwyddiannus i'w sicrhau ar gyfer 2023/2024 a thu hwnt.

Chwaraeodd y Pwyllgor Cyllid a Rheolaeth ran enfawr wrth gefnogi'r Cyngor yn eu penderfyniad i roi'r gorau i fasnachu'r Pentref Ieuenctid am 2023. Yn ei le bu'r pwyllgor yn gweithio gyda staff i ddatblygu nawdd a defnydd ehangach o'r ystafell gynadledda a'r adeilad. Fel rhan o'r Strategaeth Incwm mae pwyllgor codi arian wedi ei sefydlu ac yn dechrau edrych ar ffrydiau ariannu eraill, fel clwb 200 a digwyddiadau codi arian.

Mae aelodau'r is-bwyllgor cyllid a rheolaeth wedi bod yn gyfrifol am ystyried a monitro pob agwedd ar gyllid y ffederasiwn; gan gynnwys cyllidebu, nawdd a dosbarthu arian wrth gefn. Cyflawnwyd y gwaith hwn yn gyson gyda diwydrwydd i nodau ac amcanion y sefydliad.

## Finance & Management

The committee met several times over the past twelve months via teams and with meetings consisting of all the Wales YFC officers, who worked alongside a panel of committee experts whom the organisation is indebted to for their attendance and support, namely Kathryn Jones, Steve Hughson and Hilary Jones.

Mr Malcolm Thomas stepped down from the committee in December 2022 and was thanked for his time of which he dedicated to the organisation.

The Welsh Language grant was received and supported the Welsh Development post, other staff salaries and the 12 Counties. The day-to-day monitoring of this grant was delivered by our Welsh Language Development officer. The NFU Charitable Trust supported the Agri I programme where 8 members were funded to explore various farming practices. WCVA funding which had been initially ring fenced to support an income officer was used for the development and implementation of an Income Strategy. The NYVO funding had been lost in 2022 and the committee supported the senior staff in reapplying, with the funding application being successful and being secured for 2023/2024 and beyond.

The Finance & Management committee played a massive part in supporting Council in their decision to cease the trading of the Young Peoples Village for 2023. In its place the committee worked with staff to develop sponsorship and the wider use of the conference room and building. As part of the Income Strategy a fundraising committee has been set up and is starting to look at other funding streams. Such as a 200 club and fundraising events.

Members of the finance and management sub committee have had the responsibility of considering and monitoring all aspects of the federations finances; including budgeting, sponsorship and the distribution of reserves. This work has been consistently carried out with diligence for the organisations aims and objectives.

Wedi wythnos llawn bwrllwm cystadlu, Ceredigion oedd yn fuddugol.

Teithiodd nifer o'n haelodau i gystadlu mewn amryw o gystadlaethau NFYFC yn ystod y flwyddyn megis Ffair Aeaf Lloegr, Gŵyl Adloniant, Siarad Cyhoeddus a Chwaraeon. Pembrokeshire were the hosts of our annual Eisteddfod this year at Ysgol Bro Gwaun, Fishguard. The Eisteddfod was broadcast on S4C as well as Radio Cymru. There were big decisions to be made in the main ceremonies of the Eisteddfod with the chair designed and created by Tomos Lewis from Langlydwen being won by Lisa Angharad Evans, Eryri, and the crown created by Eifion Thomas from James Eifion Thomas Blacksmith being won by Mared Fflur Jones from Meirionnydd. Ceredigion was the winning County at the end of the Eisteddfod.

It was nice to be able to continue our partnership with Menter a Bunes and Cywain at the Winter Fair as we presented a Cywain Scholarship to a member who had planned a new business. There were various competitions from the Baby Beef to chicken jointing to decorating a chocolate log. After two days of competitions, Ceredigion and Gwent were joint winners.

The Entertainment Feast at Pontio, Bangor was next on the calendar for the members. Seven counties competed in the English section and five in the Welsh section. During the weekend the Member of the Year and Junior Member of the year competitions were held. Endaf Griffiths from Ceredigion was the winner of Senior Member of the Year and Elain Iorwerth from Meirionnydd was the winner of Junior Member of the Year. Erwood YFC from Brecknock won the entertainment competition in the English section and Dyffryn Cothi YFC from Carmarthenshire won the Welsh section.

Public Speaking Day was next on the Showground in Llanelwedd. With every County competing during the day, it was an extremely successful event. Pembrokeshire won the English section and Ceredigion and Carmarthenshire were joint winners in the Welsh section.

Ceredigion were the hosts of this year's Field Day and it was a successful day at Trawscoed Farm. After the auction, stock judging, the fashion show and the fencing, Ceredigion was victorious at the end of the competition.

Sports Day followed at Aberystwyth University with Ladies Rounders, Men's 'Rush' Hockey, Junior Mixed Basketball and Junior Mixed Dodgeball competitions.

The pinnacle of the year in the YFC competitions calendar is the Royal Welsh Show and it was a very successful week with almost 1,000 members competing during the week. It was great to develop a relationship with Teenage Cancer Trust for the Federation Display competition. It was good to see Women's Rugby developing in the cattle ring with heats on Monday and Tuesday nights and the final on Wednesday afternoon. After a week full of competition, Ceredigion were announced as the winners.

A number of our members travelled to compete in various NFYFC competitions during the year such as the English Winter Fair, Entertainment Feast, Public Speaking and Sports. As a committee we would like to thank the Wales YFC staff for all their help, to all our judges, stewards, sponsors and members for ensuring that the Wales YFC competitions calendar goes from strength to strength.

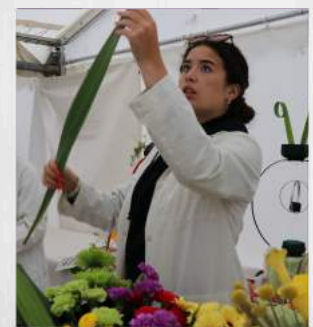

## Rural Affairs

In October 2022, 35 members travelled to Cumbria for our annual Study Tour where we saw a range of beef, sheep and dairy farming operations and visited a number of agriculture-related rural businesses.

Members from across Wales and beyond travelled to Corwen for our 'Farming Journeys' conference, hearing from a panel of high-profile speakers, learning about personal opportunities in breakout sessions, and seeking new ideas on farm visits.

We've ensured that our members' voices are heard by policy makers through consultation response workshops, and hosting meetings with Government officials to discuss responses to proposals.

Committee representatives have attended many events throughout the year, promoting new and existing personal development opportunities, from practical training courses to the recently launched Farm Business planning competition.

Prime Pork, the successor to the Menter Moch Cymru scheme was launched in July 2023 to complement our existing Prime Lamb and Baby Beef competitions.

The Wales YFC Lamb Scheme celebrated 15 years, giving members enhanced value when marketing their produce, and financially supporting the federation.

Working with our partners, we have continued to deliver farm safety awareness to our members through various competitions, and participation in events throughout the year.

Close collaboration with both public and private sector organisations ensure that we are able to continue offering our varied programme of activities, and our thanks goes to all who have worked with us during the year and into the future.

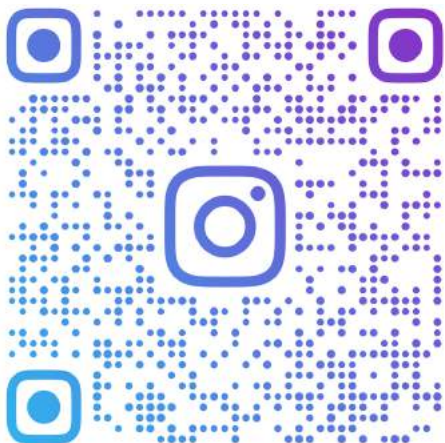

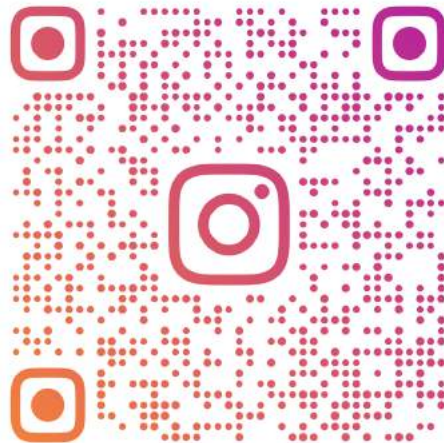

The Committee hopes to build on the great work that's been done on the social media and beyond to promote the movement to a wider audience, by working with the new Marketing Officer.

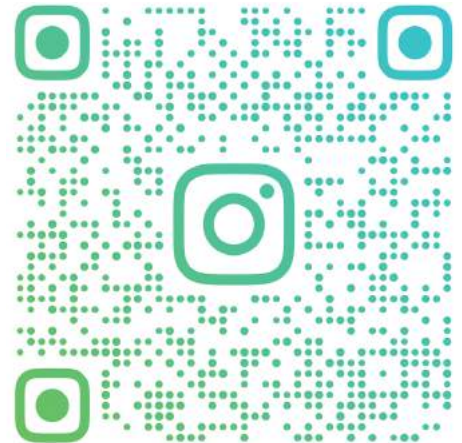

## Personnel and Remuneration Report

Personnel and Remuneration have met several times throughout the year to discuss and support staff at Wales YFC. January 2023 saw the appointment of Mared Rand Jones into the role of Chief Executive.

Claire Powell's job title changed from Finance & Administration Manager to Operations Manager having covered the role of Chief Executive for the period 1 July 2022 to 16 January 2023 whilst the organisation took time to appoint. Working now four days per week mainly office based.

Ella Jones was appointed on the 5 September 2022 into the Marketing & Communications role and left the position in June 2023 to study pharmacy in Cardiff University. Carys Storer Jones was appointed into the role just before Royal Welsh 2023 and is full time.

Lee Pritchard was appointed into the role of Rural Affairs Officer in August 2022, having done over 1 year with Wales YFC full time developing the work of the Rural Affairs committee.

Nia Haf Lewis was appointed as the Welsh Development officer in March 2022 and has since taken on the responsibility of the Youth Forum as well as Welsh Development. Nia Haf works full time and is homebased.

Rhianwen Jones has continued in her role as Competitions & International officer full time developing the work of the competitions programme and International programme.

Megan Jones works 2 days per week office based supporting staff with administration and translation.

Sally Griffiths was brought in on a temporary basis for the 2023 Royal Welsh show 4 days per week, office based with responsibility in supporting staff with administrative duties.

The building group has met with architects to discuss potential work which needs to take place on the building and has appointed Thomas Login to conduct a survey and compile plans. However, the organisation agreed that it was firstly important to prioritise the organisations finances and make sure adequate funding was in place for the movement to continue before any spend on the building was committed.

Essential work has been done to include painting of the kitchen and offices upstairs and external painting of the workshop door and booth doors. Maintenance work has been completed on the heating system and a new fire alarm system has been installed throughout the building.

The conference room has been marketed and promoted to external businesses and the facilities were used more extensively especially during the 2023 Royal Welsh Show.

The building group will continue to liaise with Thomas Login regarding the survey and plans as this piece of work is funded by the lottery. Any updates will be circulated to the buy a brick donors and a board has been erected in the kitchen area of the building noting Wales YFC's appreciation to all whom made a donation to the buy a brick appeal.
