



I am extremely proud of the subcommittees that have been running diverse and interesting events for all members. 

Prif ffocws y pwyllgor Cyllid a Rheoli ar gyfer 2023-2024 fu gweithio tuag at y strwythur Llywodraethu newydd. Mae'r pwyllgor wedi cyfarfod yn rheolaidd dros y deuddeg mis diwethaf mewn person ac yn rhithiol i gyflawni'r darn hwn o waith ar ran y Cyngor.

Sefydlwyd is-bwyllgor i orchwyllo'r datblygiad hwn a diolchwn i bawb a gymerodd ran, yn enwedig aelodau ein pwyllgor annibynnol sef Mr Steve Hughson, Kathryn Jones a Hilary Jones. Penododd CFFI Cymru JCP Solicitors i adolygu'r erthyglau presennol ac wedi hynny diweddarwyd yr erthyglau a fydd yn cael eu cyflwyno yn y cyfarfod heddiw i'w mabwysiadu. Mae'r pwyllgor wedi gweithio tuag at strwythur Bwrdd Ymddiriedolwyr newydd ac mae'r manylion wedi'u dosbarthu. Mi fydd aelodau'r bwrdd yn cael eu hethol yng

nghyfarfod Cyngor cyntaf y flwyddyn. Bydd Bwrdd yr Ymddiriedolwyr yn cynnwys cadeirydd annibynnol, Cadeirydd y Cyngor, Is-gadeirydd y Cyngor, 3 aelod annibynnol a 4 Aelod CFFI. Mae cylch gorchwyl newydd hefyd wedi'i greu ar gyfer y Cyngor a Bwrdd yr Ymddiriedolwyr.

Derbyniwyd y grant Cymraeg i gefnogi swydd y Swyddog Datblygu'r Gymraeg, cyflogau staff eraill a'r 12 Sir. Cyflawnwyd monitro'r grant hwn o ddydd i ddydd gan ein swyddog Datblygu'r Gymraeg. Cefnogodd Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol yr NFU y rhaglen Materion Gwledig gyda datblygiad y Gystadleuaeth Prif Gynhyrchydd Porc, Taith Astudio a Chynhadledd Materion Gwledig. Yn ogystal â hyn cynhaliodd y rhodd y rhaglen Ryngwladol gan ganiatáu i aelodau deithio i Ganada, Cork ac Ynys Wyth. Collwyd ein cyllid gan NYVO yn 2022, fodd bynnag, roedd cais newydd y mudiad yn llwyddiannus, a sicrhawyd cyllid ar gyfer 2023/2024 sydd wedi'i ddyrannu i gyflogau staff.

Cafodd yr Adroddiad Effaith ei gwblhau a'i lansio ym mis Ionawr 2024 yn y Senedd gyda'r adroddiad yn cynhyrchu adborth da i'r sefydliad. Rhoddodd y digwyddiad gyfle i'r mudiad hyrwyddo ein gwaith i aelodau'r Senedd, rhanddeiliaid eraill a chefnogwyr.

Mae'r gwaith wedi dechrau gyda'r Marc Ansawdd sy'n amod o gyllid y NYVO gyda'r broses efydd yn dechrau ac yn dod i ben ar ddiwedd 2024. Mae'r Marc Ansawdd yn offeryn hunanasesu rhagorol sydd yn dyfarnu statws efydd, arian ac cur, gan gydnabod rhagoriaeth mewn gwaith leuenctid. Mae'r marc yn cael ei ystyried yn uchel a bydd yn helpu ein statws fel sefydliad leuenctid gyda rhanddeiliaid a chyllidwyr y dyfodol.

Mae aelodau'r is-bwyllgor cyllid a rheoli wedi bod yn gyfrifol am ystyried a monitro pob agwedd o gyllid y ffederasiwn; gan gynnwys cyllidebu, nawdd a dosbarthu cronfeydd wrth gefn. Mae'r gwaith hwn wedi cael ei wneud yn gyson gyda diwydrwydd ar gyfer nodau ac amcanion y sefydliad.

FINANCE & MANAGEMENT

The main focus of the Finance & Management committee for 2023-2024 has been working towards the new Governance structure. The committee has met regularly over the past twelve months both virtually and in person to deliver this piece of work on behalf of the Council. A sub-committee was set up to look at this development and we thank all involved especially our independent committee members Mr Steve Hughson, Kathryn Jones and Hilary Jones. Wales YFC appointed JCP Solicitors to review the current articles and subsequently updated the articles which will be presented in the meeting today for adoption. The committee have worked towards a new Board of Trustees structure and details have been circulated with the board members being elected in the first Council meeting of the year. The Board of Trustees will consist of an independent chair, Chair of Council, Vice chair of Council, 3 independents and 4 YFC Members. New terms of reference have also been created for both the Council and Board of Trustees.

The Welsh Language grant was received and supported the Welsh Development post, other staff salaries and the 12 Counties. The day-to-day monitoring of this grant was delivered by our Welsh Language Development officer. The NFU Charitable Trust supported the Rural Affairs programme with the development of the Prime Pork Competition, Study Tour and Rural Affairs Conference. The donation also supported the International programme allowing members to travel to Canada, Cork and Isle of Wight. The NYVO funding had been lost in 2022, however a new application was successful, and funding was secured for 2023/2024 which has been allocated to staff wages.

The Impact Report was completed and launched in January 2024 at the Senedd with the report generating good feedback for the organisation. The event gave opportunity for the organisation to showcase ourselves to Senedd members, other stakeholders and supporters.

Work has begun with the Quality Mark which is a condition of the NYVO funding with the bronze process beginning and concluding at the end of 2024. The Quality Mark is an excellent self-assessment tool which then awards Bronze, Silver and Gold status on completion of each stage, recognising the excellent Youth Work. The mark is highly thought of and will help our status as a Youth Organisation with stakeholders and future funders.

Members of the finance and management sub committee have had the responsibility of considering and monitoring all aspects of the federations finances; including budgeting, sponsorship and the distribution of reserves. This work has been consistently carried out with diligence for the organisations aims and objectives.

It was encouraging to see an increase in the number of competitors within the YFC sections in both the Prime Lamb and Baby Beef, with several new faces. The champion YFC Baby Beef went to Ryan Jones, Brecknock and Iestyn Thomas, Carmarthenshire won the YFC Prime Lamb. The Prime Pork competition reached its pinnacle with Cerys Thomas, Ceredigion winning the pairs competition and Rose Lewis from Brecknock winning the singles.

The second weekend of January saw the annual Rural Affairs Conference return with the exciting new addition of the first ever Agri Awards. The conference this year concentrated on Supply Chains. Attendees got to listen to speakers discussing all aspects of the supply chain from genetics, experiences from other countries and direct selling and sustainability. Our thanks must go to CCF for their continued support in ensuring the success of the conference. The Agri Awards saw fierce competition for the four new titles. The Rural Affairs Committee and Wales YFC has representation on several Welsh Government committees and are invited regularly to give evidence at various hearings which is encouraging that the voice of the next generation of Welsh Farmers are heard loud and clear.

During the Royal Welsh Show several results and opportunities were announced. Following high interest from members for the Prime Pork Competition, 7 successful members have been chosen to participate in this year's programme and training is currently underway. We look forward to following their journey in the run up to the Winter Fair. The result of the inaugural Rural Business Innovation Competition was announced during the Rural Affairs Reception at the show, where Leah Davies from Clwyd was announced as winner. Thanks must go to Rural Advisors for their support and for holding a well-attended workshop on how to produce a business plan.

As a committee we would like to thank the NFU Mutual Trust for their continued support throughout the year in various competitions and events. As we look forward to the next year, on behalf of the committee I would like to thank Lee Pritchard for all his support during his time in post and welcome Angharad Davies.





With another YFC year coming to an end, and my time as Wales YFC International Chairman coming to a close, it's been amazing looking back at all that has been achieved as a committee over the last 12 months.

The year has been full of many exciting opportunities for members of Wales YFC to take advantage of. At the beginning of the year we saw the release of the 2024 travel programme, which had a number of different trips to apply for, from our big trip to Canada to smaller trips to Cork, the Isle of Wight and our mystery trip made a comeback yet again. I believe the amount of members who applied is a testament to the Wales YFC travel programme. We had over 90 members apply for the variety of trips which we had on offer, and interviews took place in October, when a total of 176 interviews were undertaken, and our lucky candidates were chosen for their trips by 5 different panels. Including the cruise, 78 members from across Wales went travelling through the international programme in 2024.

Not long after selection day, 4 members from Wales YFC headed up to Edinburgh for the first ever 5 Nations Conference held by SAYFC. Over the 5 days of the conference, there were many activities and discussions to be had between the nations on the subject of "Rural Leadership". Feedback from the members who attended said that it was a very insightful weekend which led to really good conversations between the nations. We're looking forward to attending the next 5 Nations conference in Northern Ireland shortly.

Again this year we worked with the Wales YFC Youth forum committee to hold our second residential trip, this time to Gwersyll yr Urdd Glan Llyn. We had junior members from many different counties all come together for two days, jam packed with activities. From high ropes to rafting, teambuilding to bowling, they were kept busy and we finished off the weekend with a farm tour. It was great to see members from across Wales coming together and making new friendships over the course of the weekend, and I would like to thank everyone who took time out of their weekends to help facilitate the Youth forum residential to happen.

With the summer months fast approaching, we already began to see members embarking on their travel opportunities with members going to the Rural Youth Europe events, Canada and the Isle of Wight, and with everyone preparing to go on their travels we had to then arrange our international reception for the Royal Welsh show! There were many faces to be seen at the reception, with representatives from the various trips Wales YFC had on offer as well as members of SAYFC, NFYFC and YFCU. During the reception we took the opportunity to launch not only our big trip for our 2025 programme which was to Patagonia, but also launch the return of the New Zealand Dairy Scholarship which will be making its return to our travel programme in 2025. We were also very lucky to have the Young Farmers Ambassadors present at the reception who very kindly presented us with £300 from the Wales YFA reunion and £500 from the England and Wales YFA. As a committee we are incredibly grateful for these donations, and encourage anyone who has been travelling through Wales YFC to look at the next YFA reunion which will be in Ramada Plaza, Wrexham, from the 25th to the 28th October 2024, which all travellers are eligible to go to!

Our most recent trip which has recently been completed was our Wales YFC cruise. 37 members boarded a Marella Cruise which took them all around the Mediterranean where they went sight seeing, starting in Palma, before travelling and making stops in Ajaccio, Rome, Florence & Pisa, Toulon and Barcelona. This was a great opportunity for so many members to see many different places all in one trip, and everyone thoroughly enjoyed! Hopefully we can continue and do something similar in the future!!





BUILDING GROUP REPORT

We continue to liaise with Thomas Login, our chosen architect, who have completed the latest set of drawings and plans for the YFC Centre. The National Lottery, People and Places grant has been secured to cover the cost of this element, and will need to be spent by the end of 2024. The drawings have been shared with the wider public, in a bid to engage with everyone possible to have an input, we all know of the outreach YFC has, and its involvement in so many peoples lives, being it past or present members, we believe it very important to allow people the chance to be involved, to accumulate as much knowledge and feedback as we can.

I'm glad to report the engagement has been successful, with strong feedback from the Royal Welsh where the drawings were launched on display outside the YFC Centre as you enter the main reception, along with a short survey to be filled.

The plans and survey have been shared to the website and social media, with a link for anyone to engage in the survey and share their thoughts. This too has been very promising, with numerous responses received. I thank everyone who has taken the time to share their views. The survey ties in to our next chapter as a group. Any new development will require significant funding, Thomas login will be working on predicted costs to any new development, and we therefore look to the future on how to finance any potential work. Cwmni Burum has been approached, who bring grant applications expertise to the table. Initial collaboration has been very positive, and we look forward to working with them to aid us in this area. The survey plays a vital role in having evidence and feedback towards any grant application.

The Buy a Brick money remains ring fenced and secure, ever since the successful purchase and completion of the head lease for the Building, once again I thank those who donated, without whom we wouldn't be in this position.

The building has been continuously used throughout the year by external users for meetings, conferences and training. With a range of different organisations and businesses utilising the space. The use of the meeting room has become more popular during the Royal Welsh Show week, with the space being rented out on an hourly basis. The central location on the show site proves popular with hirers for receptions and small functions during the week.

Looking ahead the Building group will be continuing to promote the survey, and talks will begin with potential project managers to assist in the next stage of any developments. All costs including a project manager will be factored into any future grant applications
